Bear Hill Camp at Bear Brook State Park, NH

Bear Hill Camp offers Overnight, Mini, and Day Camps with programs focusing on swimming, arts and crafts, nature, outdoor education, environmental activities, canoeing, program electives and *fun!*

Traditional Overnight Camp \$400/week Ages 7-17 years Sunday to Friday
Gain skills, create friendships, and sample a wide range of topics: nature, crafts, archery, sports, science, swimming, and boating. Enjoy special evening programs and campfires.

Mini Camp \$300/session Ages 6-12 Sunday to Wednesday

Oceanography – Cape Cod Adventure Aug. 16-22 \$900
Investigate the dunes of Cape Cod, visit the Woods Hole Oceanographic Institution and tour Cape Cod lighthouses. Explore the Cape by bike, and take the ferry to Martha's Vineyard. (Please note special **Saturday check-in** time.)

Climatology – White Mountain Adventure July 20-25 \$600
Explore the site of the world's worst weather, our own Mount Washington. This session will be held off site, with overnights at the NH Outing Club cabin in Jackson, NH, the Mt. Washington Observatory Weather Discovery Center in North Conway, NH, as well as Barry Conservation Camp in Berlin, NH.

Mentor Program Ages 16 and 17 6-week program June 29-Aug.8 \$1200/session
This program introduces participants to the responsibilities and job requirements of the counseling staff at Bear Hill Camp. Candidates must submit a letter of interest (indicating what they would like to gain from this program) with completed registration form and deposit. Future Countdown Durham Campus June 29-July 4 \$600

Where do *you* want to be in five years....and how do you plan to get there? Attend this informative, hands-on seminar to explore some of the many options on your horizon. If you are currently a high school freshman, sophomore or junior, we invite you to join us for a week on the beautiful University of New Hampshire Durham campus. Meet with University Admissions Department personnel, tour the Durham campus and the surrounding seacoast area, stay in a dorm, eat in the dining hall, speak with UNH students and enjoy the UNH recreational facilities!

Equine Seminar Durham Campus July 6-July 11 Ages 13+ \$600

Explore the world of horses with the guidance of 4-H and Equine Specialists and faculty. Investigate horse biology, nutrition, biomechanics and medical care. You will also travel to area horse training and medical facilities to see horses and equine professionals in action. Experience firsthand the many facets of the equine world. Stay in a dorm on the UNH Durham campus, eat in the dining hall and enjoy campus recreational facilities!

Barry Conservation Camp, Berlin, NH

Barry Conservation Camp is located in the White Mountain National Forest at the Fish Hatchery in Berlin, NH. This 4-H camp is operated in conjunction with NH Department of Fish and Game. Barry Conservation Camp emphasizes environmental awareness, responsible use of firearms, safe hunting practices, conservation principles and ethics. Of course, there is also swimming and canoeing in York Pond, as well as group activities that encourage teamwork. The camp provides a close-knit community for its 35 campers and eight staff.

Let's Go Fishing! July 6-11 Ages 10-17 \$400

Come catch that big one! Novice anglers will learn the basic skills and equipment needed to get started fishing, while campers with more experience work on improving their fishing skills and exploring the finer details of the angling world. We will go on a fascinating tour of the hatchery and find out why it was built there. A visit from the local conservation officer will help us learn about the rules, regulations and ethics surrounding fishing. But that's not all! We will also study the ecology of and discover the birds, bugs and beasts of the lakes, ponds and streams at Barry Conservation Camp. Come ready to get wet, smell fishy and meet new friends.

Shooting Sports Sampler July 13-18 Ages 10-17 \$400

Learn marksmanship, the safe and responsible use of firearms, principles of hunting and archery, conservation ethics, and much more. Explore the 4-H disciplines of black powder, riflery, pistol shooting and archery. Previous shooting sports experience is helpful, but not required.



Hunter Safety & Certification Program July 20-25 **Ages 12-16 Only** \$400

Taught by NH Department of Fish & Game staff and volunteers. Learn and practice safe hunting skills and behaviors. Explore wildlife biology and hunting ethics. Practice daily at the shooting range. As this is an intense training, you'll receive a training notebook in advance. Develop competencies to become certified.

Open only to those without current hunter education certification.

Walk on the Wild Side July 27-Aug.1 Ages 10-17 \$400

In America's technology-based culture, the gap between youth and nature is growing. Experience nature and reunite with the great outdoors. Create a meal from gathered plants, fillet a fish and cook it over an open fire, sleep under the stars, climb a mountain, swim in a pond, create nature crafts, and more. Truly experience the great outdoors.
